### Added new providers

Inviting the best possible providers into our community and supporting them is essential to ensuring access to high-quality care. This year, we added providers in orthopedics, pediatrics, general surgery, urology, interventional radiology, hospital medicine, cardiology, vascular surgery, neurology and oncology.



### Donated nearly \$12.1 million in services to those in need

### Paid \$18,643,124 in taxes
